Tennis Court Guidelines:

- ✓ **Play at your own risk!**
- ✓ Be respectful of others.
- ✓ Children under the age of 18 must be monitored by an adult at all times.
- ✓ University classes, intercollegiate & intramural players have court times.
- ✓ Non-reserved courts are available on a first-come, first served-basis.
- ✓ Observe a one-hour time limit when others are waiting.
- ✓ Only shoes with white rubber soles are allowed on the court.
- ✓ Motorized vehicles, bicycles, tricycles, rollerblades, roller skates, wheelies, scooters, skateboards, barbecues, alcohol, glass containers, firearms, & weapons are not permitted within this facility.
- ✓ Animals must be on leashes & under direct control of owner.
- ✓ Do not deface, destroy, or remove the University's property or plant life.
- ✓ Do not climb on the fences.
- ✓ Courts are open from dawn to dusk; however, the University may close the courts to the public at any times without prior notice.
- ✓ Parking is permitted by the university permit in campus parking lots only. Illegally parked vehicles may be cited & towed.

San Francisco State University reserves the right to refuse, restrict, & terminate court access without prior notification. Violators of the tennis court guidelines are subject to arrest & prosecution pursuant to CHC Section 602.
